

BREEDING OF WINTER CEREALS TO BENEFIT NO-TILL ORGANIC PRODUCTION SYSTEMS

Summary

This breeding program is targeted towards developing cover crop characteristics that support weed management and tillage reduction as part of a sustainable cropping system. The program will evaluate fall rye and triticale cultivars with potential to develop winter hardy cultivars with early heading, thin stems and low regrowth for better rolling and crimping.
